Ontario Minor Field Lacrosse League 2010

13. Rules of Play

- Section 1. F.I.L. rules will be in effect for all games unless otherwise directed and approved by the league and Ontario Lacrosse.
- a) All players' sticks must abide by the F.I.L. specifications, but full wooden sticks are not to be allowed.
 - b) **Game Times – League Games/Provincial Qualifiers & Championships**
 - i) Under no circumstances shall any official, coach, manager be allowed to change the times of quarters or games
U9 (commencing 2010) modified rules, use Turkeyshoot rules and field size

Novice & PeeWee:	12 minute quarters (last 2 minutes of 4 th quarter stop time)
Bantam & Midget:	15 minute quarters (last 2 minutes of 4 th quarter stop time)
Half Time:	5 minutes
Time Outs:	2 per game
 - c) A team is deemed to have defaulted a match, when they have insufficient players to start the game, fifteen minutes after the scheduled start time.
 - d) A game shall be considered a complete game if the 3rd quarter has been started and it is called due to poor weather or field conditions. A game can only be cancelled_ with the consent of game day convener.
 - e) Total points win league. If teams are tied at the end of league play, the tie will be broken as per O.L.A. Constitution (R1.06 (a)).
 - f) Tied games will stand in regular season and qualifier play.
 - g) Tied games in Provincials, will be played as follows:
 - Two 4 minute halves, running time
 - If necessary,
Sudden Victory will be played using 4 minute running time quarters
 - h) Slashing will be called tightly.
 - i) If a team has more than a 7-goal lead, face-offs after a goal will be cancelled in favour of possession at center to the losing team.
 - j) The Designated Defender rule will be used.
- Section 2. Bench Officials / Balls
- Each team must provide one stop watch per game
 - Each team must provide a scorer, or timer, and a ball retriever per game
 - Each team must also supply two field lacrosse balls per game
- Section 3. C.L.A. Field Lacrosse game sheets will be used for all sanctioned games.
